

# Combat Food Insecurity in San Antonio

Food insecurity is defined as a lack of consistent access to sufficient, safe, and nutritious food which meets dietary needs and food preferences for an active, healthy life.

Food insecurity is also

- a household-level economic, social, and environmental condition of limited or uncertain access to adequate food.
- worrying about where the next meal will come from and can lead to missed meals and poor health outcomes.



**In America, more than 44 million people struggle with food insecurity, with 13 million being children.**

14% of San Antonio population is considered to be food insecure.

18% of San Antonio population is under the federal poverty line.

35% of San Antonio population is considered “working poor”.
